### What is LETRS?

*LETRS* (Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling), written by reading expert Louisa Moats, Ed.D., is a training delivered through a series of modules. *LETRS* is not a reading and spelling program; it is knowledge that is meant to deepen teachers' understanding of reading and spelling instruction.
